Downriver Attorney Randall Pentiuk named in 2007 Michigan Super Lawyer

The 2007 Michigan Super Lawyer announces that attorney Randall Pentiuk has been listed as one of its "Super Lawyers," a distinction reserved for the top 5% of the legal profession. Pentiuk, the managing shareholder of the Downriver firm of Pentiuk, Couvreur & Kobiljak, P.C., serves as City Attorney for the City of Riverview, Corporation Counsel for the City of Melvindale, General Counsel for the Charter Township of Royal Oak, and Corporate Attorney for the Downriver Community Conference. In addition, he represents public housing commissions, condominium and community associations, and has a statewide practice representing housing cooperatives.

A magna cum laude graduate of the Detroit College of Law, where he served as an editor on the Law Review, Pentiuk first worked in the legal profession as a Research Attorney in the Michigan Court of Appeals. Admitted in Michigan and the District of Columbia, Pentiuk serves on the Boards of Directors for the National Association of Housing Cooperatives and the Midwest Association of Housing Cooperatives, where he is also the Michigan Vice President. He is a frequent author and lecturer on legal issues involving housing cooperatives, having written two primers on the subject.

Pentiuk is a member of the Michigan Association of Municipal Attorneys and the International Municipal Lawyers Association, where he has served as Chairman of the Litigation Section. He is also a member of the American Bar Association.

Active in the community, Pentiuk serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Detroit Rescue Mission Ministries and is on the Volunteers of America - Michigan Board of Directors. The father of four daughters, he and his wife reside in Riverview.
